

#### HARVESTING TO COMMENCE

Contract Crews will be immediately commencing machine harvest as part of this Ecosystem Enhancement Project. This work will be taking place on 7agam Lands forming Kootenay IR 1, in an area known as the Airport Pasture, and expected to be completed early February 2023. Please be advised that trucks and equipment will be seen along gravel service roads, as well as LD Ranch and Mission Roads. Community members accessing the project area are asked to look for signs indicating active logging/hauling and adhere to any safety precautions requested.
