








Wetlands provide food and water sources for many plants, animals, insects, and microbes.

## First Nations Drinking Water Settlement Claim





COMPLETED COMPENSATION CLAIM FORMS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THURSDAY, MARCH 7, 2024

ALL REGISTERED ?AQAMNIK ARE ENCOURAGED TO SUBMIT A CLAIM, EVEN IF YOU ARE FEELING UNSURE ABOUT IT!

You may be eligible for compensation if you are a First Nation individual and you dealt with a drinking water advisory on Kootenay IR 1 that lasted at least one year between September 20, 2013 and June 20, 2021.

## Lands Department Updates



BC Hydro will be onsite starting January 22<sup>nd</sup> to do some vegetation removal around their poles. This work was scheduled to happen in December but was postponed. It may take a few weeks to complete this work. If you have any questions/concerns you can contact the BC Hydro representative Mark Krahn at 250-919-2761.

#### Wetland Restoration

The Lands Department has been continuing to work on the Wetland (?akaq̂ŧa?haŧ) Restoration Project with the wetland restoration specialist, Rewilding Water and Earth. This spring we plan to have a hydrological study completed, and inventory made of plants near the wetlands, and further arcehology assesments completed. We hope construction can begin in

area to help determine where seeding could be focused to help with erosion control and to mitigate invasive species from spreading. Their report outlined high, moderate and low priority areas, a native seed mix suggestion, and various seeding methods. We will use this report to help guide us in out wildfire recovery work reguarding invasive species.
