As you may have heard, we are taking a rest year from goat grazing. Thanks to the BC Hydro Community ReGreening Program, we have begun spreading a Grassland Restoration seed mix within Long Prairie, along the roads, and near Adrian Lake. We are focusing on spreading the seed where there is cheat grass in hopes of the native plants to outcompete this invasive species. We plan to do more seeding in the fall to encourage the native plant growth next spring as well. Updated Post-Secondary Policies!

Highlights:

= All programs (including Trades, regardless of length) are eligible if offered by an eligible institution and offers a certificate.

[Archived - List of eligible post-secondary education institutions in Canada \(sac-isc.gc.ca\)](#)

= No limits within levels! If you have previously been funded for a certificate, diploma or degree, you can be sponsored again for a similar credential.

= No longer requirement to be funded at the rate of the closest Institution, including foreign institutions (where you can be funded at the actual cost in Canadian Funds).

= Application and assessment fees are eligible for reimbursement upon sponsorship approval.

= No maximum amount for Books, Supplies and Equipment, including technology. We can fund actual costs for any items listed as **required** in the course syllabus.

= Part-time students may be eligible for some pro-rated living allowance and travel with specific needs outlined in their letter of intent.

= Continuous intake for applications for short-term programs will be accepted throughout the year.

= Living Allowance monthly rate based on this formula:

Minimum wage x 35hrs x 4

Currently: \$16.75 x 35 x 4 = \$2,345 per month for single student

Students with 1 Dependent + \$750.00 = \$3,095/month

Students with more than 1 Dependant + \$750 -\$3,845.00 maximum
