PRESCRIBED BURN PLANNED FOR SPRING 2023 ON ?AQAM FEDERAL RESERVE LANDS

February 14, 2023

Paġamnik and area residents are advised that Paġam, in conjunction with the BC Wildfire Service, are planning to conduct a 1,240 hectare prescribed burn between April 1- April 30, 2023, weather and burning conditions permitting. The prescribed burn unit is immediately East of the Canadian Rockies International Airport and extends East to Mission Road on Federal Reserve lands described as Kootenay IR No. 1.

The prescribed burn is being conducted for ecosystem enhancement purposes- to improve biodiversity while reducing wildfire risk. The practice of using fire (?a·kinquku) to support ecosystem renewal and health is a management practice that has been implemented by ?aqam for generations.


This project will improve habitat for several species including Elk (kiłġa#i), Deer (zupqa), Flammulated Owl (kupi), Lewis' Woodpecker (kazkaz) and Little Brown Bat (?a·kłum).

To accommodate sensitive wildlife species the burn will not take place after May 1st. Over the likely twoday ignition period, area residents can expect to experience periods of smoke. However, the burn will be conducted under weather conditions that will minimize the impacts and duration of smoke. Public safety is paramount so access to the burn unit will be limited until the area can be assessed for danger trees and hot spots.

INVITATION TO QUOTE PRESCRIBED BURN PREPARATIONS CONTRACT MARCH-MAY 2023

Location

Kootenay IR No. 1(see attached map).

Timeline

- Weather permitting, all field work must be completed by March 31, 2023.
- Reporting must be completed May 31, 2023

Deliverables 1. Wildlife Tree Raking

- 79 wildlife trees, ranked as High and Very High value, require the raking of ground fuels to a 3m radius on each tree to reduce the risk of fire spread to the tree (GPS locations will be provided for wildlife tree locations).
- Ensure that no piles or accumulations result from the removal of the fuels, as this will put the wildlife tree at increased risk
- Document with Photographs:
 - Pre-treatment: Document wildlife tree or patch with two photographs. One photo which best shows tree characteristic or condition, ie: basal scar, (closer photo) and one photograph which shows the overall tree (+/-full tree).
 - Post Treatment: The Contractor shall document the prepared (raked) tree to show treatment conducted. It requires one photo per tree showing the tree condition and protective results pre burn.
 - Post Burn, the contractor shall revisit and re-photograph each treated tree post burn (May 2023) to document success of treatment.
- Report is an excel spreadsheet that includes site locations and photo documentation, as above.

2. Fenceline Post Raking

- 2.75 km of fenceline raking- All wooden fence posts require raking to bare mineral soil 20 cm around each post
- No treatment required for spacers between posts

3. Corral

- Dig a fireguard 30 cm in width and down to bare mineral soil around the corral at a distance of 20 m from the structure.
- 4. Signage Removal/Installation
- Remove and collect any visible signage in the project area.
- Reinstall signage post prescribed burn.

<u>Insurance</u>

The Contractor shall ensure that the proper licenses and insurance are carried as defined by local, provincial, or federal laws/regulations.
