

WETLAND RESTORATION TREE THINNING

The Lands Department is working on the next phase of the Wetland Restoration Project – tree thinning.

By creating a more open forest area, there will be less trees taking up water and therefore, more water available for the wetlands. This work will also help reduce wildfire risk.
